Safety is very important when working with resources in problem solving.....

General Laboratory Rules

1. No one is to leave the room without permission of the instructor.
2. Laboratory work is to stop immediately when clean-up is called.
3. Students will leave only when dismissed by the instructor.
4. Take pride in your lab, keep it clean and organized.
5. As soon as you enter the technology laboratory, go to your assigned seat. Have homework or other class materials ready. Be organized and ready to start. There is no talking after the bell.
6. Place all equipment back in its proper place by the end of the period.

Laboratory Safety Rules

1. Never operate laboratory equipment on which you have not had proper instruction by the instructor.
2. Never run or fool around in the technology laboratories.
3. Never work in the technology laboratory without your safety glasses on.
4. Never distract the attention of anyone operating a machine.
5. Never operate a machine without rolling up long sleeves and pulling back hair, removing neckties, and securing dangling jewelry.
6. Never leave a machine running, turn it off and wait for it to stop running before you walk away.

7. One person will operate a machine at a time.
8. Never try to stop any machinery with your hands, tools, or materials.
9. Stay atleast three feet from anyone operating a machine.
10. Carry tools with care to avoid injury to yourself and others.
11. Report any safety hazard to the instructor immediately.
12. Report all injuries, no matter how slight, to the instructor immediately.
13. Never leave sharp pieces of metal or other materials sticking out from the benches or vises.

Safety Grade

At the start of the marking period you will receive a safety grade of 100%. In order to maintain the grade you must follow the safety rules during your laboratory work time.
