Requests of Capital Committee

- All members of WCSD Board of Education have security access to all buildings
- Request the Architect and WCSD to look into possible permeable paving to all the parking lots.
- Recommendation for the Public Relations Committee publish a press release regarding the bus garage and the
 results of the vote to not purchase of the new district office
- Floor plan of the new district office be distributed
- When the new transportation facility is up and running, would like the air quality tested and monitored to confirm safety to the children on the Fishkill Plains playground.
- How much are the deposits for both 167 Myers Corners and 160 Airport Drive?

New Projects

- The WCSD Board of Education approved the Buildings Condition Survey to be performed by Rhinebeck Architecture. This survey will identify the current building needs that should be addressed.
- Athletic Fields
 - Rhinebeck is working on a design new Dug outs at John Jay High School and a new Press Box for Roy C. Ketcham High School. SED needs plans, they need to approve, then will issue permits.

- Phase 1 Window Update; met with Principals and staff at each school
 - Fishkill Plains windows have begun
 - Van Wyck is scheduled to start on July 20th
 - Roy C. Ketcham will begin in August and will be completed on 2nd shift; waiting for a preliminary schedule.
- Security Project Update
 - Security front entrance modifications have begun.
 - Wire Pulling at Brinckerhoff will be completed Friday; Vassar Road is next, then to Fishkill Elementary.
 - Doors electrified with badge readers are independent of each other; each time the door is opened, it is documented.
- Phase II Update:
 - New Bus Garage:
 - Black top is complete, striping is being done today.
 - Van Wyck Junior High
 - Bus parking lot is complete except for fencing and lighting; buses are parked on site.
 - Parking lots in front are all dug up right now, putting in conduits for lighting.
 - Wappinger Junior High Bus Parking Lot
 - New bus drop off and parking lot under construction; MacDonald Way is temporarily closed to local traffic until completed, the towns were notified and metal sign is up.
 - Kinry Road and Evans Elementary Schools heating and ventilation systems are being constructed. All univents at Kinry have been removed, new one's are on sight; asbestos removals has been completed. Evans abatement will start on Friday, July 10th.
