PE CREDITS

Dr. Bonk provided information regarding concerns that may arise with a policy for students to earn PE credit for their participation in outside sports.

- Consider the scheduling component since school semesters don't overlap with sports schedules/seasons
- Process for verification of hours and by whom
- Definition of an "accredited" national affiliation sport
- Provide specific distinction of a competitive sport that has a nationallyrecognized affiliation

The district already has a policy for PE credit for interscholastic sports for students in grades 10-12. The committee would like to see this expanded to include grade 9.	
Chairperson Pelton will look at policies in other states to develop a model program. Questions to ask include: what is the scope/how is it working; what is the percentage of success; and how many students participate.	NEXT STEPS
